**EXERCISE OF EXIT OPTION FOR THE AWARD OF
 THREE-YEAR BACHELOR'S DEGREE UNDER FYUGP**

This is for information of all concerned that the **Exit Option** for students intending to exit after successful completion of the **Three-Year Bachelor's Degree under FYUGP** has been enabled through the **Samarth Student Portal** <https://nowgongcollege.samarth.edu.in/>

Eligible students who wish to avail the Exit Option are required to submit their online application through their respective Samarth Student Login during the period **20 July 2026 to 27 July 2026 (up to 11:59 P.M.)**.

Students are advised to carefully read and follow the instructions contained in the **“User Manual for Students to Apply for NEP Exit Policy”**, enclosed with this notification, before submitting their applications.

It may be noted that:

1. Only those students who submit the Exit application through the Samarth portal within the stipulated period and are found eligible under the applicable regulations shall be considered for the award of the **Three-Year Bachelor's Degree**.
2. **Hard copies of the Consolidated Grade Sheet shall, in the first instance, be issued only to those eligible students who have exercised the Exit Option.**
3. Students intending to continue to the **Fourth Year of FYUGP** are **not required to apply for the Exit Option**. The hard copies of their Consolidated Grade Sheets shall be issued separately at a later stage.

No request for exercising the Exit Option shall be entertained after the expiry of the prescribed application period.
