We are elated to welcome the new batches of students to the 2025-2026 academic year of our college under NEP-2020. We are proud to announce that Nowgong College (Autonomous) is upgraded to the status of a university by the Nagaon University Act 2023. This academic transition will definitely change the face of higher education in middle Assam. Currently by being an Autonomous College we have the privilege of self-governance and we offer courses and programmes with contemporary significance and career-oriented facilities. Our institution has the autonomy to incorporate up to 30% changes to the UGC syllabus of Postgraduate and Undergraduate courses, because of which we are incorporating course units with more pragmatic value and local significance. This has paved a new path for our institution, ensuring flexibility and career opportunity for our students. The current year shall offer courses based on NEP with more skill-oriented programmes. It is noteworthy that NEP emphasizes on value-based education and employability. Enrolment in Academic Bank of Credit is compulsory for students. A remarkable academic achievement of our institution is that we have introduced Ph.D. programme in nine departments from 2022. This is nevertheless a symbol of another path breaking achievement of our college, which has created a wider scope of research in the institution. Moreover, there are fifteen Add-on and certificate courses and recently we have introduced more than thousand MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses), which have enabled our students to learn new subjects. Under these courses our students are privileged to learn from renowned academicians and resource persons from different fields. Our institution has also started a language laboratory to offer courses on the tribal languages of the state. It is a unique and innovative practice for preserving and teaching the local languages, which are otherwise marginalized in the mainstream. The college is also registered under NTA as a participatory institute for CUET Examination. The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) has recently recognized Nowgong College (Autonomous) as a institution for offering the Integrated B.A. B.Ed. course from the academic session 2025-26 under Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP).

We want to emphasize that our institution does not merely focus on producing students who excel academically but also grow in the innovative, cultural and the creative realm and would have the potential to contribute to the nation with their talent and originality. We inspire the new generation to explore and to create. We sincerely believe that Nowgong College(Autonomous) is the platform where students get the best opportunities to fulfil their dreams.

The alumni of our institution have shown excellence in various fields – their persistent success and achievement in cultural, academic, literary and all other areas of activities have made us proud. The college has installed close-circuit cameras to ensure security in the campus. We have an anti-ragging cell which keeps a strict vigilance to prohibit ragging in the campus. Our college offers free coaching of Civil Service examinations and National Eligibility Test (NET). THE COLLEGE

Nowgong College (Autonomous) is located in the centre of Nagaon town. This institution has a rich legacy, as it was established during the colonial period in India and later came to be associated with many renowned personalities of the state. At present the college possesses a group of extremely dedicated, experienced and professionally outstanding faculty members. Moreover, the college has a Wi-Fi enabled campus and sophisticated class rooms with modern teaching-learning aids. The college offers ICT facilities to the students to make them technologically well-versed. It has digital class rooms and a digital library. The central library of the college owns about 60,200 books, a significant number of journals, periodicals and e-journals. It is notable that the Placement Cell of the college regularly organises personality and soft-skill development programmes among the students and ensures the placement of successful students through campus recruitments.

THE CAMPUS

The Nowgong College (Autonomous) campus is extremely safe and congenial for the students. The college administration has installed close circuit cameras to keep a constant vigilance on the campus and to ensure security of the students. The college has a rich infrastructure, the architectural designs and establishment time of which range from the colonial time to the present. The College campus has a ramp facility for differently abled individuals. There is a continuous air quality monitoring system installed under National Clean Air Programme by Pollution Control Board, Assam. Assam Gramin Vikas Bank is situated within the college premises to provide easy banking facilities to the college fraternity.

The infrastructural set-up of Nowgong College is spread across different blocks, the details of which have been given below:

ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK

The administrative block includes the Principal's Chamber, Teachers' Common room, Office, Seminar halls, Language Lab etc.

SCIENCE BLOCK

The science department with laboratories and class-rooms are built in a separate set-up.

ARTS & COMMERCE BLOCK

This academic block comprises mainly of the different departments belonging to Arts and Commerce. The Accounts section of the college is also located within this block.

Academic Ability and Potential

Teaching-learning Methods

We are committed to encourage and develop enquiring minds and to provide unparalleled learning opportunities for our students. Besides conventional classroom teaching, ICT enabled teaching-learning methods are widely used in the college. There are ICT enabled class rooms in each department and smart class room in some departments. The college has one YouTube channel where faculty members contribute their lectures. Individual academic YouTube channels of many teachers are linked to the college website for easy accessibility. The college has the online resources such as Swayam-NPTEL, e-pathsala, infibnet and Nowgong College (Autonomous) You Tube channel etc. Lecture programmes, seminars, webinars, interactive programmes, etc. by leading academicians working at the forefront of their fields are regularly organised to expand the learning horizon of the students. Field trips, exposure visits are organised to impart knowledge of outdoor experiences.



Collaboration with other institutions

The college, in collaboration with different institutions viz., IIT Guwahati, IIT Bombay, IIT Kharagpur, IEE Guwahati, IEST New Delhi, Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute, Dafodil College of Horticulture, Sense Education (for Japanese Language) and Rainforest Research Institute (RFRI) organizes different programmes of academic and socio-cultural interest. Various research programmes have been undertaken with different leading institutions.

The College is running spoken tutorial programmes in collaboration with IIT Bombay under National Mission on Education through ICT: MHRD, Govt. Of India, to spread IT Literacy all over India. The learning and usage of the Free & Open-Source Software is made possible through an Audio-Video teaching tool via this programme.

Sarothi - The Time Bank

Nowgong College (Autonomous) has recently started a Time Bank which is named as 'Sarothi-The Time Bank.' It is a barter mechanism which allows its members to 'deposit' and 'withdraw' personal time, depending on their ability and requirement. Our college has started the Time Bank with an altruistic purpose. It has facilitated its members to volunteer to take care of elderly people related to the college fraternity. The board of 'Sarothi- The Time Bank' consists of the Principal as the chairman, the two Vice-Principals as board of Directors, Chief Managing Director, Assistant Chief Managing Director, two teacher members nominated by the chairman, two students members (the President and the General Secretary of the Students' Union) and the members of the NSS.

Let us go to school - School Mentoring Programme

Nowgong College (Autonomous) has initiated a school mentoring programme under the aegis of IQAC, NSS & NCSU to provide mentoring facilities to the nearby schools within Nagaon district.

Libraries

Nowgong College (Autonomous) offers you an incomparable library facility, both in its conventional and sophisticated modes:

The college library contains both text books and reference materials. There is an E-Library and E-Corner facility for the students. There are about 60,200 books, 8,000 back volumes, 20 journals, 18 news papers, 6,000 e-journals and 1,64,300 e-books in the library.

The departmental libraries help the students with books, journals and periodicals which are more subject-specific. The departments with post-graduate course receive an extra fund every year for purchasing important text books and reference books.

The digital library of the college has opened up a wider vista of knowledge and information for the students through online journals and other web-materials.



Laboratories

Botany, Chemistry, Education, Geography, Physics, Statistics and Zoology departments have laboratories for students of UG & PG programmes with necessary basic facilities. Departments of Botany, Chemistry and Zoology have well equipped laboratories with sophisticated instruments. Recently, a Micro Biology Lab is set-up in the department of Botany with adequate facilities for UG & PG students.

Under the guidance of a number of faculty members along with the Principal, Nowgong College provides research support and facilities to the aspiring research students in various fields of Arts, Science and Commerce. The digital library in the college offers journals and other study materials for research work. Many faculty members are serving as Principal Investigators in various research projects funded by different agencies of Govt. of India.



Biotech Hub

Institutional Advanced Level Biotech Hub, funded by the Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India, provides infrastructural facility to enhance science education & research and to inculcate scientific temper and spirit of inquiry among the aspirants.



Life at Nowgong College (Autonomous)

Hostel

Admission & Courses

Admission in the college is done strictly on merit basis. The reservation policy prescribed by Govt. of Assam is thoroughly followed. Nowgong College (Autonomous) offers Undergraduate programme with honours courses in most of the subjects in Science, Arts and Commerce. It also offers Postgraduate Course in Assamese, Botany, Commerce, Chemistry, Economics, Education, English, Geography, History, Philosophy, Sanskrit and Zoology.

- Through the Non-CUET portal, where admission is based on HS-12 marks.
- Through the CUET portal, where admission relies on the CUET score.

Infosys Springboard

Nowgong College (Autonomous) is the first college of Assam to have an exclusive MICROSITE developed by INFOSYS SPRINGBOARD to select and add any courses from 20,000 courses of Infosys springboard free of cost.

There is scope for the students to check the status of course completion, certification, enrollment status by visiting the site. Even there is a facility to update any MOOCs course related news on this microsite. Through this academic pursuit it will help the institute in smooth implementation of NEP-2020. More than five hundred students have already received course completion certificates from reputed universities in different courses. There is a scope to update all facilities (relating to MOOCs) available in the college.


During the first semester, courses from Infosys Springboard were introduced in two distinct categories: Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) and Value-Added Courses (VAC). Under the AEC category, the course selected was Business English Networking, and it was successfully completed by a total of 450 students. As for the VAC category, three courses were chosen: Our Energy Future, Model Thinking, and Philosophy, Science, and Religion: Religion and Science. These courses were completed by 15, 20, and 5 students, respectively.

Similarly, for the second semester of FYUGP 2025-26, Nowgong College (Autonomous) has expanded its incorporation of Infosys Springboard MOOCs into three course categories: AEC, VAC, and Skill Enhancement Course (SEC). Within the AEC category, Business English: Management and Leadership was chosen, and it attracted the enrolment of 1100 students. In the VAC category, courses such as Big Data, Artificial Intelligence, and Ethics; Next Gen Technologies; and AI Artificial Intelligence with Python were selected, collectively attracting around 450 student enrolments. For the SEC category, courses including Programming Fundamentals using Python - Part 1, Internet of Things 101, IoT Edge Computing and IoT Analytics, IoT Platforms Overview, and IoT Communication Technologies were chosen, and they garnered around 650 student enrolments.

Important Instructions :

- Students are advised to choose Major and Minor Courses from the same basket and choose an Interdisciplinary course from the basket – A/B/C (As per UGC guidelines students are not allowed to take the same courses studied in the 12th Class under the Interdisciplinary category). Also they must choose any one course as SEC from the Basket D.
- Students having CGPA 7.5 are allowed to take research in 4th year otherwise he/she have to take another three papers.
- Students exiting the programme after securing 44 credits will be awarded UG Certificate in the relevant Discipline/ Subject provided they secure 4 credits in work based vocational courses offered during summer term or internship/ Apprenticeship in addition to 6 credits from skill-based courses earned during first and second semester.
- Students exiting the programme after securing 88 credits will be awarded UG Diploma in the relevant Discipline/ Subject provided they secure additional 4 credit in skill based vocational courses offered during first year or second year summer term.

Undergraduate Courses

Major: The students of the Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) are required to demonstrate a general understanding of the natural sciences, social sciences, humanities, interdisciplinary studies and vocational education as well as in depth study of at least one subject area which will be Major Course for the first to third semester. The requirements for major courses would be 48 credit-hours. The Major may be chosen from the basket of courses shown in page no. 12. A student can declare Major only at the end of third semester provides he/she secure minimum 50% of total credits through core courses.

Minor: In addition to the disciplinary/interdisciplinary major courses a student may choose two disciplinary/interdisciplinary "Minor" for fourth, fifth and sixth semester of 16 credit-hours each (32 credit-hours in total), including skills based courses relating to a chosen Vocational Education Programme. For example, if a student pursuing an Economics Major obtains a minimum of 12 credits from a bunch of courses in Statistics, then the student will be awarded B.A degree in Economics with a Minor in Statistics.

Research Oriented Courses, Internship & Research Project: At the beginning of seventh semester each student will take up a research project along with advanced disciplinary/ interdisciplinary courses and research methodology courses. All students pursuing the Four Year Bachelor's degree with Honours/ Research will also undergo 4 credit internships with faculty and researchers at their own or other Higher Education Institutes / Research Institutions during the 8th semester. This will lead to entry into one year Post-Graduate & Ph.D programmes in a phase wise manner.

Postgraduate Courses

Postgraduate programmes under NEP 2020 will begin from the session 2024-25.

Ph.D Programme

Nowgong College (Autonomous) has started Ph.D programme from the session 2022-23. Currently nine departments viz., Bengali, Botany, Chemistry, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Philosophy and Zoology are offering Ph.D Courses. The programme has nevertheless paved the way for more research activities in the institution. The selection board has followed all the necessary rules and regulations to select the research scholars for the Ph.D course in the above mentioned departments.

Add-on courses

Add-on courses are introduced in Nowgong College (Autonomous) with an aim to expand learning platforms for the students so that they learn additional subject(s) apart from their main courses. Following interdisciplinary add-on courses are offered by different departments of the college.

Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)

Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) is a dual-major, four years undergraduate course. Ed.. This course is allowing students to become qualified teachers in four years. Under this course, students gain expertise in both their chosen subject area (arts, science and commerce) and teacher education. It aims to provide a comprehensive education in a shorter timeframe compared to traditional B. Ed. Programme. This course focuses on practical teaching experiences, academic coursework, pedagogy, classroom management and teaching methodologies. National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) introduced the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP). ITEP seamlessly combines general education with professional teacher training, offering a holistic, multidisciplinary approach to teaching which is aligned with the National Educational Policy (NEP) 2020. It is a flagship programme under the National Educational Policy (NEP) 2020. The college operates in full compliance with the guidelines set forth by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Assam, as well as the University Grants Commission (UGC). This step helps the institution to provide high quality higher education and prepares the learners to become efficient teachers in different stages of school education.


